

- The structure of the (future) TARGET guideline is stable.
- ☐ Feedback from market participants has been reviewed and where relevant incorporated in the Guideline.
- □ Drafting of the appendices to the Guideline (technical, governance and legal) is commencing with a view to completion early in Q3 prior to submission to the legal and policy committees as planned. The submission to the decision making bodies is expected for the end of 2021.
- Guideline publication is foreseen for Feb 2022.
